- value chain as grid, interfacing with all 3 spheres (PPP)

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





#### Practice in Auroville




- · AV food system governance: multi stakeholder platform
- research findings: per capita footprint, consumerproducer-partnerships (CPP)
- questions:
  - cash premiums / food smiles (LETS)?
  - can diets be influenced through collective kitchens?
  - can financial sustainability be achieved through carbon credits, agritrourism, ecosystem services?









### Relevance for urban planners

- include food security and food sustainabiliy in core services offered to residents
- plan for total footprint of urban community (energy, water, land & services consumed)
- CPP options: CSA, fairtrade + organic farmer groups, town-village twinning, contract farming
- collective kitchens: central meeting place, community building, hub for information on sustainable lifestyles

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### Relevance for urban planners

- include direct, long term market linkages in design for "project livelihood"
- include ecosystem services as value adding
- CPP options
- community enterprises: collective QC, logistics, marketing, extension, community development/ investment (CBO)

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
